Criteria 1	1 Enter-proceed to A-halt-acknowledge judge.
Max Points	<p>10 ~ Confident with self – calm with the alpaca – aware of what the alpaca is doing- able to take a straight line- eye contact and smile for judge.</p> <p>5 ~ <i>Lacking confidence – tugging/dragging alpaca-not paying attention to alpaca-wandering- no acknowledgement for judges.</i></p>
Criteria 2	2 Advance to B-turn right & proceed through markers to C.
Max Points	<p>20 ~ Confident with self – calm with the alpaca – aware of what the alpaca is doing- able to take a straight line -gives alpaca sufficient room to turn corner- able to move freely through markers – giving alpaca room to move.</p> <p>10 ~ <i>Lacking confidence – tugging/dragging alpaca-not paying attention to alpaca-wandering-difficulty rounding corner-bumping into markers-knocking markers over</i></p>
Criteria 3	3 Turn at C- advance diagonally to D with loose lead.
Max Points	<p>20 ~Confident with self – calm with the alpaca – aware of what the alpaca is doing- able to take a straight line- handler and alpaca both relaxed</p> <p>10 ~ <i>Lacking confidence – tugging/dragging alpaca-not paying attention to alpaca-wandering-poor cornering</i></p>
Criteria 4	4 Turn left and go through arch E
Max Points	<p>15 ~ Confident with self – calm with the alpaca – aware of what the alpaca is doing – handler gives self sufficient room to turn corner easily – able to lead confidently through arch.</p> <p>7 ~ <i>Lacking confidence – tugging/dragging alpaca-not paying attention to alpaca-wandering-crowding at corner –unable to lead through arch</i></p>
Criteria 5	5 Advance to pen F- open gate with assistance from steward- enter pen and remove halter and put back on.
Max Points	<p>20 ~ Acknowledges stewards assistance - Confident with self – calm with the alpaca – aware of what the alpaca is doing- able to smoothly remove halter – able to smoothly replace halter with minimum of fuss – talks to alpaca quietly.</p> <p>10 ~ <i>Ignores assistance- agitated with alpaca- unable to remove and / or replace halter-unable to restrain alpaca</i></p>
Criteria 6	6 Leave pen – advance to G- turn left and exit
Max Points	<p>5 ~ Confident with self – calm with the alpaca – aware of what the alpaca is doing-gives alpaca room to corner – gives self room to corner smoothly</p> <p>2 ~ <i>Lacking confidence – tugging/dragging alpaca-not paying attention to alpaca-wandering-poor cornering</i></p>
Criteria 7	7 Overall presentation of the combination of handler and alpaca
Max Points	<p>10 ~ Handler presents self clean and tidy – sturdy clean shoes- Shows confidence with own ability – treats the alpaca well in a quiet calm manner - move easily together – shows awareness of and respect for the alpacas needs.</p> <p>5 ~ Handler presents dirty – untidy – dirty shoes-lacks confidence and ability to lead alpaca– shows little or no awareness and respect for the alpacas needs.</p>
